Applications will be selected by the Concert Series Committee with input from co-sponsors and according to the following criteria:

- Music must be “family friendly” in order to achieve the funding’s goal of “covering all age groups and segments of society.”
- A diversity of genre and geography that represents AFM Local 433’s jurisdiction will be sought.
- Additional consideration will be given to musicians who have not already performed for an MPTF Event in the last year.
